We are disappointed that although we submitted our request three (3) weeks ago, we have yet to receive any response. Given UPEI Administration's public commitment to implementing these ventilation mitigation measures and the fact that the Fall 2022 semester is right around the corner, we believe it is imperative that students, faculty, and staff have a full appreciation of the work that has been completed to improve classroom air quality and ventilation.

Finally, we would like to reiterate our call for a comprehensive evaluation of the ventilation systems for all campus workspaces.
