## **UPEIFA / UPEI Collective Bargaining - Statement of Difficulties**

## 5 August 2022

After many bargaining sessions with our employer, it has become clear that there remain significant disagreements between the parties. While we have made some progress on a few issues, there has been little if any movement on a number of the most significant issues.

The most intractable difficulties involve negotiating language around greater accountability and transparency, improving working conditions (and students' learning conditions), health and safety, equity, diversity, and inclusion (EDI), reasonable workloads, collegial (shared) governance, normalization of contract academic staff, salary/benefits and adequate teaching/research supports.

We look forward to working with a conciliation officer to endeavour to bring about agreement between the parties.
